HDJ Design Group's landscape architects provided plant design and architectural design concepts for Hapo Community Credit Union at Southridge Village.

As a corner anchor development to Southridge's commercial site, the client requested a bold and colorful plant concept that would market their building in a functional way. Another challenge for this site was Central Washington's regional extreme climates and harsh winds. HDJ encouraged the use of rock and complimenting plant materials with limited lawn areas to address the concerns of the

area and client. As a result, less watering and the conservation of natural wood resources made the design a sustainable solution.

Further developing the ideas of the client's goals, HDJ proposed columnar evergreen tree accents, a mix of colorful perennials/shrubs and added vines along trellises to soften and accent the stone-veneer building. The design concept established a landscape standard for the client's future credit union buildings and also met the design guidelines of the City.
