

Springbrook Village Multi-Family Residential

Springbrook Village is a 16-building, 296-unit multi-family residential housing development in Vancouver, Washington. It was built by a private developer and is owned and operated by the Vancouver Housing Authority. HDJ's landscape team assisted the architect during the site planning phase by helping to select automobile and pedestrian circulation route options and building pad locations that would preserve existing large oak trees.

HDJ's civil engineering and landscape departments worked together



to give the stormwater retention pond an attractive appearance with a variety of shoreline plants to avoid the need to mow steep grass slopes. HDJ also designed a shared private access road to serve the site.
