Phase One of this project included a 26,000-square foot, two story office building for the Vancouver Housing Authority offices, with parking. The goal of this phase was to create a signature building that would mark the north entry to newly revitalized upper Main Street, also known as “Uptown Village.”

Phase Two of this project focused on creating “Uptown Village”, designed to provide a 5-acre mixed-use environment for one of the older historic neighborhoods in North Vancouver. The layout includes a



blend of primary uses, including affordable housing units, town homes, retail at street level, underground parking, a central plaza and an elegant streetscape tying all project aspects together. The central street acts as a corridor which can be easily transformed into a pedestrian-only area during festivals and events. This project has been a welcome addition to the urban open spaces within the neighborhood.
